Statement of Attainment in Individual Support (Disability Care)

ABOUT THE COURSE

This short course aims to equip individuals with the skills and knowledge required to provide empowerment of people with a disability and independent and wellbeing support. It involves following and contributing to an established individual plan.

COURSE CONTENT

You will learn how to:

- CHCCCS023 Support independence and wellbeing
- CHCDIS007 Facilitate the empowerment of people with a disability

These units of competency apply to workers in a residential or community context, including family homes. Work performed requires some discretion and judgement and may be carried out under regular direct or indirect supervision.

STUDY COMMITMENT

This is a part-time course - Online or Work-based.

Enrolments must be commenced by 31 August, 2022 and training must be completed by 31 October, 2022.

FEE-FREE*

To be eligible for a fee-free* place you must meet the Smart and Skilled eligibility requirements below:

- Be aged 15 years or older
- Live or work in New South Wales
- Have left school
- Are an Australian citizen, permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen

Eligible participants can currently be working and/or seeking employment in the Aged Care and Disability industry.

This fee-free* course is conducted under the NSW Government's Skilling For Recovery initiative as part of the JobTrainer scheme.
