This short course is the perfect way to gain employment in this high-demand industry and pursue a rewarding career.

COURSE CONTENT

This skill set reflects the skill requirements for supporting people with disability. This short course will help you gain the skills to:

- CHCDIS007 Facilitate the empowerment of people with disability
- CHCCCS015 Provide individualised support
- CHCCOM005 Communicate and work in health and community services
- HLTWHS002 Follow safe work practices for direct client care

COURSE DURATION

This short course can be completed via blended learning (e.g. combination of face-to-face and online)

Enrolments must commence by 30 November, 2022 and training must be completed by 28 April, 2023.

FEE-FREE*

To be eligible for a fee-free* place you must meet the Smart and Skilled eligibility requirements below:

- Be aged 16 years or older
- Live or work in New South Wales
- Have left school
- Are an Australian citizen, permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen

and also be one of the following:

- Leaving school permanently in 2022, i.e. Year 11 and 12 school leavers; or
- Not at school in 2022 and no more than 24 years old.
