COURSE CONTENT

You will learn how to:

- SITXFSA001 Use hygienic practices for food safety
- SITHCCC001 Use food preparation equipment
- SITHCCC002 Prepare and present simple dishes
- SITHCCC003 Prepare and present sandwiches
- SITHCCC011 Use cookery skills effectively
- SITHFAB002 Provide responsible service of alcohol[^]
- SITHFAB005 Prepare and serve espresso coffee

Upon successful completion of this course, participants will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment.

COURSE DURATION

This is a 5 day course. Face-to-face classes are conducted at our commercial restaurant in Bankstown.

Enrolments must commence by 30 November, 2022 and training must be completed by 28 April, 2023.

FEE-FREE*

To be eligible for a fee-free* place you must meet the Smart and Skilled eligibility requirements below:

- Be aged 16 years or older
- Live or work in New South Wales
- Have left school
- Are an Australian citizen, permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen

and also be one of the following:

- Leaving school permanently in 2022, i.e. Year 11 and 12 school leavers; or
- Not at school in 2022 and no more than 24 years old.
